

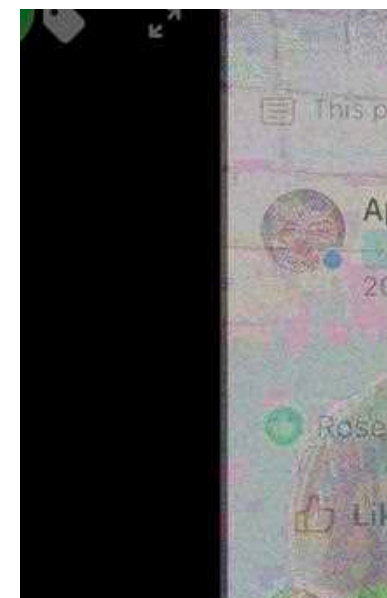

## Refit of council houses

At our June TBRA meeting, Clair Dowds from SHDF (Social Housing Decarbonisation Fund) spoke at length about the refit process for our estate. Ours will be the second wave with Netherfield being the first. Although the houses are different, lessons will have been learnt from Netherfield's refit.

In July the council started work on a trial empty property (2 Congreave). The programme of works should take approximately 4 - 6 weeks, weather permitting. The retro fit is all about reducing energy bills and working towards carbon neutrality. The houses are currently on energy band D and band C is the target.

Our council houses will have new roofs and more insulation. Windows and front and back doors will be replaced. Houses will have passive air vents and new guttering too.

An open visit to the trial property will be arranged for all those concerned. Be prepared to be contacted by an independent government group although you don't have to take part. The refit will be disruptive but it will be worth it in the long run
