- Liaising with various organisations/shops who supply goods
- Sorting the rota of volunteers
- Picking up and dropping off collections throughout the week
- Bagging up items on a Friday
- Ensuring health and hygiene rules are obeyed
- Displaying all the goods
- Date labelling the frozen goods

- Setting up the tables, chairs and shelving
- Making a video of what's available for Larder members
- Manning the Larder (and checking members in)
- Manning the Community Fridge
- Weighing the Fridge contents
- Putting back all tables, chairs and shelving
- Sweeping and cleaning the floor
- Record keeping on Friday and Saturday Reporting back to Neighbourly, Food Connect, Food Diverse and Woughton Community Council

Neighbourly consideration

- Place your waste and recycling on the <u>boundary</u> of your property no earlier than 5pm the day before and take your bins in asap
- Having a bonfire? Alert the neighbours and DON'T burn anything toxic like plastic.
- Keep your dog on a leash on the estate and pick up your dog's mess and dispose of it responsibly.
- Having a party alert your neighbours and keep the noise down after 11 pm
- Park considerately

Inconsiderate parking

Parking that obstructs a driveway is against the Highway Code.

According to the Highway Code, drivers should not park in front of somebody's driveway. Rule 243 states that motorists must not stop or park "in front of an entrance to a property".15 Aug 2023

While this is not a criminal offence, law enforcement officers may be called and may order the vehicle to be towed away at its owner's expense. It would be good to report persistent offenders to the police and hope that they take action.

Use a yellow battery bag!

Last month a resident put spent batteries in one of their rubbish bins which resulted in a fire in the back of the refuse lorry. All had to be emptied and put back. It could have been a big disaster. It cost time and money for the council to deal with this mistake. Act responsibly.

Put your old batteries in a yellow battery bag.



A replacement yellow bag should be left under the lid of your green wheelie bin when the full one is taken. If you require a yellow bag email customerservices@milton-keynes.gov.uk or call 01908 252270 and they will post one out to you.

Alternatively pop along to our local Tesco Express and put them in their special container.
