DUMPED RUBBISH

We are seeing an increase in dumped rubbish and we are working with Woughton Community Council and Milton Keynes Council to catch the culprits.

Ways to get rid of your rubbish:

Break it down and black bag it.

Clothing can go to charity.

White goods and metal items - call the scrap man.

Wooden items can be broken down.

Book a collection through the council.

Registered waste collection vans

Ask friends and neighbours to club together to make it less costly.

Waste collection day is Wednesday.

Put waste out the night before or before 6am on a Wednesday.

Do NOT put waste out before that, it is classed as fly tipping.

Report fly tipping to MK council

Report the reg number if you have witnessed it.

You will have to log in initially and create a password. This will allow you to report: Noise, Litter, Dog fouling, Dead animals etc.

LET'S TAKE PRIDE IN OUR ESTATE

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations in some elections. From October 2023 it will also apply to UK General elections. If you don't

have accepted photo ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document, which is known as a Voter Authority Certificate.

We recommend that you apply for a postal vote.

In the Spring

Avoid hedge cutting during the main breeding season for nesting birds, which usually runs throughout March to August each year. This can be weather dependent and some birds may nest outside this period, so it is important to always check carefully for active nests prior to cutting. Continue to feed the birds during spring and provide clean water. It's important to clean and disinfect bird tables and feeders too.



Bird Rescue

On a cold February day Allie Short our resident wildlife expert rescued this poor weak and starving goose up at the city near Grafton Gate. After much TLC the bird decided to return to its original home where surprisingly there's a little wildlife haven. Allie regularly feeds him there.
