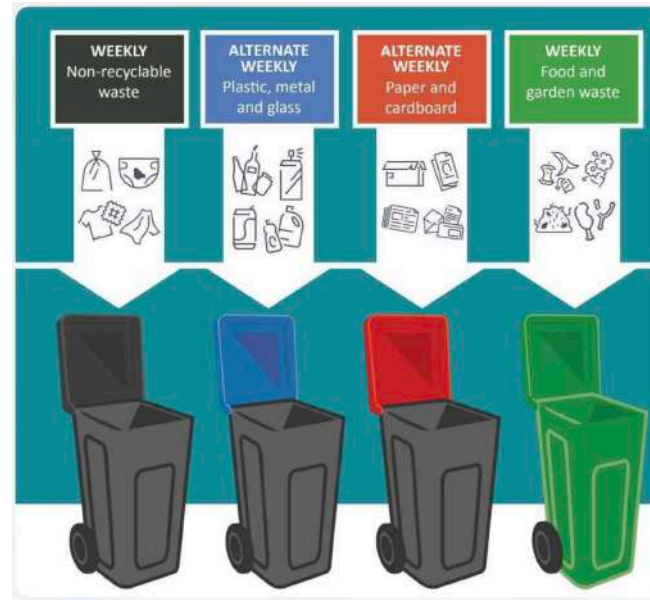

Cat Microchipping

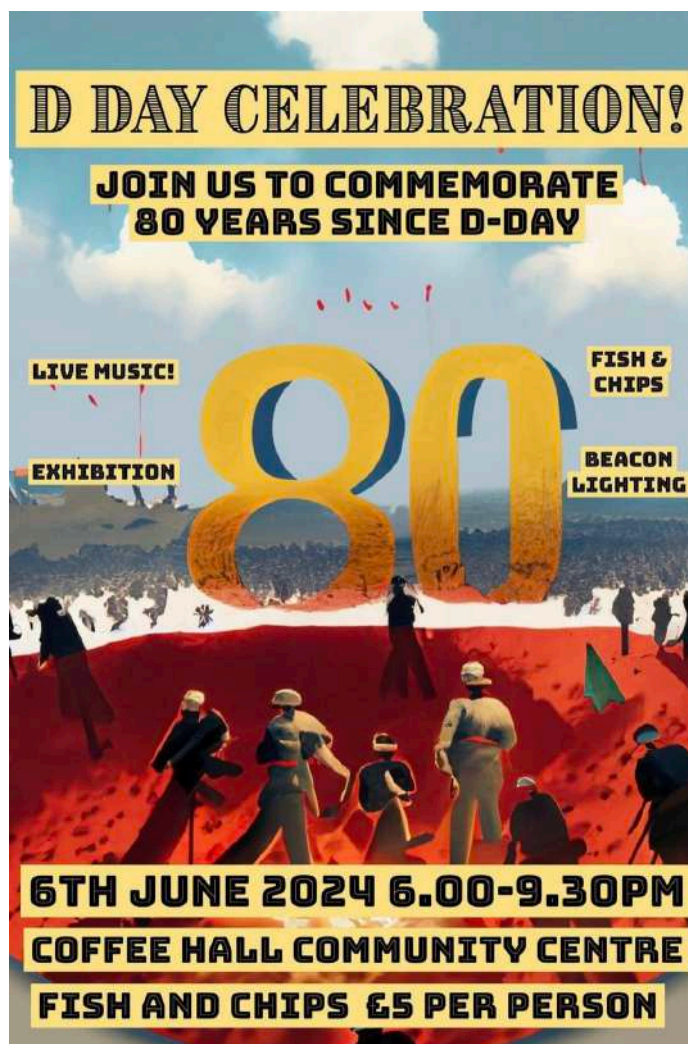

Nesting Birds

Spring is here and the birds are nesting. Please do not cut back hedges or trees during the nesting season from February to the end of August. Disturbing nests can cause birds to abandon their eggs and their chicks.

Remember too that taking birds' nests or eggs is illegal. Birds need feeding in Spring and Summer as well as in the cooler months.
