

Refit - the final push

On July 2024 the council started work on a trial empty property (2 Congreave). At the last TBRA meeting it was announced that there were only 8 units waiting for main works completion. However we realise there are multiple snagging issues for Mears to deal with. There have been problems with down pipes, internal cracks, electrics and clearing up. If you have any issues regarding the refit then contact Mears in the first instance. Any queries should be addressed to Resident Liason Officer or Mears office on 0330 123 2522. If the problem is not resolved then contact Councillor April Rennie. If she doesn't hear from you she will assume all is sorted and the work is satisfactory. It's a government expectation that Mears do an Air Test on each refit and then assuming all has been made good there's a formal sign off.
