Apologetics - None

The Chair welcomed everyone and called  
Councillor Paul from the Thames Valley  
Police to update us on crime figures for  
Tidmarsh Bridges. They did not have any to record  
but were willing to take questions and  
answer queries.

These were as follows:-

- 1) A car parked on Council land without no proper  
license plates.  
A Technically, no crime has been committed, but  
the police would look into it and advise  
the registered keeper.
- 2) A Guy Bottles exploded next to a Clip Van.  
A The Council have been told and the Bottles  
have been removed.
- 3) Can we do anything about large car

Carriers coming through the estate.

A The police cannot do anything about it, but we could apply to NK Council and/or the Parish Council for a  $7\frac{1}{2}$  ton restriction notice at both entrances to Frierns Bridge.

4) Q What can be done about a license revenue there are of course paid on the land and on the road?

A If there is an obstruction to the public or the highway, then the police can act. If a business is being run from the license, then Trading Standards need to be made aware of it.

5) Q Can cars park on the corner of a road?

A If they are within 10 metres of the road, this is an offence. The police can take steps, firstly, by warning the offender, secondly, issuing a ticket.

The Parish Council and NK Council plus various agencies are looking into the problem and trying to find a solution.

The TBLA can issue their own letter to all licensees, advising them of the problems of Careless parking and asking them to more considerate or put an article in the newsletter.

6) Q How many calls - one incident does that & an emergency. Do the police more & uninvited visits from the police.

## Environmental Report.

All is OK. The raised beds have been done and the community garden is nearly finished. The alleyways are tidy and litter-pickup is being done.

The track at the back of Lelane is blocked and there is a lot of rubbish there. It needs to be cleared. The Parish Council has cleaned the paths.

There used to be a path by the beach, but this has disappeared.

We could get in touch with the Canal Trust and the Waterways and the Parish Council.

## Update on Regeneration and ReRE.

TBRE has been asked to send 4 people to a meeting on 5th April at the Council Offices. This has been arranged by ReRE and the Council would like to <sup>see</sup> discuss looking at regeneration and ~~what~~ people want from it in regard to "People", "Place" + "Prosperity".

Statistically, we are very low scores in Crime, Income, Employment and Education which puts us in the category of being ~~as~~ ready.

How can we improve these figures?

However, we are in the top 10% in terms of Environment, which is encouraging.

Because of the Council Elections being held soon, regeneration has been put on hold and the meeting on the 5<sup>th</sup> April, must not affect what happens at the elections.

Volunteers willing to go to the meeting were Barry Lee, Rosemary & Cliff (if the others available).

MK Council are planning to definitely build 500 houses, but it could be increased to a 1000 houses. The current waiting list is 2000 people.

An average rent for a 3 bed council house is at present £190.66 p.

John went to a regeneration meeting and there was presented a group that had been set up on the Lakes Estate by the Council Office and the Residents Association claim there are many unhappy about it as this group is possibly illegal.

The title or proposal that was support the Lakes Estate Residents Association is standing up for their constitution.

He asked for a Show of Hands and the result of this was very positive.

### First Steps Working Group

The accounts for 2018/19 have not been signed off. There is a very healthy balance and some money has been ring-fenced.

John asked for a sum of £1000  
to allocate some money (£100) for the  
ink and the printing. Meeting approved.

### Funding Committee Update:

The constitution had been updated and  
the accounts signed off. This is necessary

To have in order that we may be able to obtain any grants that we need.

We have formed the Play Association and anybody who looks after children's activities has to be DBS checked and the Play Association needs to either see certificates of people who are DBS checked or help them make sure to obtain their DBS certificate.

If the Play Association agree to help us to get them Easter Egg Hunt. But we need to see the certificates.

This is funded by a grant from Councillor Pauline Prep and £30.00 is donated by the PA as well.

### Summer Event

A Sports Event and a Picnic are 2 suggestions already made, but we need volunteers to help make these events.

Caroline has suggested setting up a fitness booth for women to meet together for gentle exercise and a cup of tea.

A Mind Body and Spirit event could be organised in the autumn.

There is £5000 left in the grant funding per ab we are likely left in which to claim it. A request needs to go to ab.

Sue asked for the approval from the meeting to apply for some extra funding for the environmental team.

### Bins
