### 6 Environmental Report

Not much to reports, Ron has been poorly. John and Neasham have been watering flowers. April and others have dug up George's flower bed and replanted. Also 2 flower beds in the meeting place garden. There are more flowers to be planted too.

Lee mills has been watering the flowers, beds & Christmas tree regularly for us, he used the water pots if we are not at the meeting place so that they are still being watered.

Charlie also fed the flower beds with miracle grow to help them flourish.

When Tesco close for the refurb, they are digging up the flower beds outside and replanting with all year-round plants that will be harder. They close on the 5<sup>th</sup> of august at 8pm and reopen the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September. They want people from Tinker's bridge to be present at the opening.

#### 7 Funding Update

We have been awarded £779 applied for, for the seaside trips, £100 for activity packs for the kids and the rest for the coaches. These will be £6 a seat, Brighton is fully booked already and South-end only 6 seats left to sell. We were late getting funding in, so we have to move the dates from dates we initially wanted.

The summer fun day, April has not applied for the funding as she has not had anything in with quotes to apply for this. Natalie has said her heart is not in it right now. Kerry and Chantelle have been booking in for this and taking lead on booking stalls, food vans, etc.

We have said that people can have a stall but they will need to contribute 10% of what they make during the day.

Christmas, we have been given the 17<sup>th</sup> of December to do an event. We need to get selection boxes in for the Santa trip around the estate. It was agreed that we do a Christmas party as we haven't for the past few years due to Covid restrictions. Santa (Bill) is doing the estate rounds but will need to confirm if he can do the party after this also, need to confirm with Donna.

### Updates on Regeneration MK and RoRE Meetings. 8 RoRE are still having regular meetings so we can keep an eye on what's happening and any updates. They have changed the model of regen from demolishing the 7 estates to a business plan to spend 35M a year to spend on the council house maintenance, all paid from council house tenants rent. Some houses on Tinkers Bridge are having new kitchens and or bathrooms, there seems to be no plan or schedule on these it seems to be who screams the loudest. Donna says there is a programme that is depending on funding. Wave 1 is retro fit, starting in Netherfield, houses will be retro wrapped, new windows, cladding, internal insulation. This will be much later 2022. Wave 2 will extend to the rest of Netherfield, much later in 2023. Officers are confident that there will be a 3<sup>rd</sup> wave that will extend into Tinkers bridge, but this is dependent on when funding is released for this. Donna says most houses are in energy rating D, is any work gets done and puts them in energy rating C, then funding will not be allowed, therefore some work is slow at the moment to prevent this. 9 Reports from RAN meeting by David Residents' association network meeting, there were 4 min subjects covered, lets recycle right, plastic ocean, small actions, big impact & superpowers.
